NEXTBAT Project Marks Milestone with First Review Meeting

On **12 February 2025**, the NEXTBAT project reached a significant milestone: the **first review meeting**. This online meeting, **attended by the Project Officer and all Work Package leaders**, was a key moment in the project's progression. It marked an important step as the **Project Officer assessed the advancements made in each Work Package**, ensuring that all objectives and **deliverables outlined in the Grant Agreement** were being met.

Progress Through Collaboration

Launched on **June 1, 2023**, and funded by a **nearly €5 million Horizon Europe program grant**, NEXTBAT has made significant strides through strategic consortium meetings. In **its latest review meeting a key checkpoint in the project's ongoing evaluation**—Work Package leaders showcased **progress in cell development** and the **creation of two prototype modules** for high-power, high-density energy applications.
